



# **Opening Types**

A quick guide to the common window configurations



#### Side Hung

The most recognisable casement. It is hinged at the side for easy opening.




#### Top Light

A fixed pane divided from a narrow glazed tophinged casement.



### Sliding Folding

The sash is hinged so that it folds, increasing the area of openable window to an almost clear expanse.



# Top Hung/Awning

A casement window that is hinged at the top. Perfect for wet climates as it blocks out rain.



## Bottom Hung/Hopper

A casement window that is hinged at the bottom. Most commonly used in basements.



## Centre Hinge/Pivot

A window that is hinged in the centre to allow for a wider opening, it requires less of a swinging clearance.
